Nestlé is a Swiss Company founded by Henri Nestlé nearly 150 years ago. Today Nestlé is the world's largest food manufacturer employing nearly 330,000 people globally, with 461 factories in 150 countries. Nutrition, innovation and environmental protection have been core values of Nestlé since the very beginning. However, in a world with rapidly growing population, limited resources, and with the dual burden of obesity and malnutrition a truly sustainable food business needs to create value for both shareholders and society in parallel. Consequently Nestlé integrates a Creating Shared Value (CSV) approach to doing business with special focus on Rural development, Nutrition and Water. Nestlé tops leading sustainability indices among food companies such as the Dow Jones Sustainability Index as well as the Oxfam sustainability scorecard. Nestlé employs over 1750 people in its four Hungarian factories, exporting more than 80% and with investments totaling HUF 70 billion since it has started its operation in Hungary in 1991.
